SUBJECT: SOILS TRAINING WORKSHOP

The Environmental Engineering Program will conduct two Soils Training Workshops on June 12 and 13, 2008 and October 23 and 24, 2008. These trainings are funded in part by the CT DEP through the US EPA Nonpoint Source grant under section 319 of the Clean Water Act. Peter Fletcher, Certified Professional Soil Scientist and Certified Professional Soil Classifier, will be the keynote speaker. Topics to be covered include:

- Introduction into CT Landscapes
- Using the New Soil Survey Maps
- Identification of Soil Features
- Site Hydraulics
- Field Training
- Health Code Requirements
- Leaching Systems

The trainings will be held at the Tolland County Agricultural Center in Vernon, CT. The cost of each two-day workshop is \$35.00 for local health officials and students, and \$150.00 for installers, engineers and other interested parties. Pre-registration for each workshop through Train Connecticut is required due to space limitations. There will be no registration at the door.

Registration

To register for this training class:

1. Log on to <http://ct.train.org>, via the Internet to set up your personal account. (If you already have a TRAINCT account, skip to #3)
2. Click on the “**Register**” button in the left hand margin and complete the online registration form to set up your account. Once your account has been set up, you are ready to register for the class. (There is no cost to set up your account.)
